## ZELDA MASON APPOINTED PRESIDENT AND BOARD CHAIR OF FERD & GLADYS ALPERT JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE AND MELVIN J. & CLAIRE LEVINE JEWISH RESIDENTIAL & FAMILY SERVICE

**WEST PALM BEACH, FL – July 1, 2020** – Zelda Mason was installed as President and Board Chair of Ferd & Gladys Alpert Jewish Family Service (Alpert JFS) and Melvin J. & Claire Levine Jewish Residential & Family (Levine JRFS) for a one-year term at the agencies' 2020 Annual Meeting, which took place virtually, on Monday, June 29, 2020. She is a current Member of the Board of the Fellowship of Christians and Jews, and a past Board Member of the Armory Arts Center, as well as Founding Chair of the Alpert JFS Chai Society.

She will lead the 2020-2021 Board of Directors for Alpert JFS and Levine JRFS. Officers for Alpert JFS include: Vice Presidents Donald Abrams and Vivienne Ivry, Secretary Diann Mann, and Treasurer Alan I. Goldberg (Mann's and Goldberg's roles extend to both agencies. Carolyn Gleimer Silbey will serve as Vice President for Levine JRFS, and serve as a Member-at-Large for Alpert JFS, joined by Jason DelGrosso, Neil Efron, Ellie Hart, Bob Herzog, Robert Keats, Stacey H.
