WEST PALM BEACH, FL – March 16, 2021 – Pam Wiener, Ph. D., director of the Guardianship Program at Ferd & Gladys Alpert Jewish Family Service (Alpert JFS) will be participating in and presenting as a panelist at the 4th Annual Clerk’s Statewide Investigation Alliance (SIA) Training Symposium on Wednesday, May 5, 2021. The training will be offered via a virtual platform administered by the Florida Court Clerks and Comptrollers (FCCC) association.

Wiener, a professional guardian, and her fellow panelists will be covering Guardian’s Duties for Medicaid Benefits Eligibility, Mental Health Substance Abuse/Alcohol Abuse, and End of Life.
